Logo Spec

To ensure the quality of our website for our users and fair treatment among our listing partners, we require a minimum specification for files submitted to us.

Minimum file size: 600px height x 1440px width

Aspect Ratio: 2.4 : 1

Color Space: RGB / 8-bits per channel

Acceptable Files: Highest Quality JPEG or PNG

Bio Spec

Under your logo, we provide an opportunity for you to say what makes your business great! This is the perfect place to include a phone number or address.

Max Word Count: 60 Words

General Rules

We require that your logo be placed on a white background. We recommend logos that are wide, or that symbols be placed on either side of a text-based logo. These will work best with how listings are displayed online.

We do not allow images that include phone numbers or addresses. Please provide that in the bio section for your business.

We do not allow images that use excessively saturated colors unless your business uses these colors across media outside of ourKids Magazine.

The sample here uses a white background, and takes advantage of the space provided effectively. This would be approved for a listing on ourKidsMagazine.com



This sample would be approved, but doesn't effectively use up all the space provided. It may look small on the website.



This sample would not be approved because the background isn't white. We require the use of a white background.



This sample would not be approved because it includes information beyond the logo. That information can be provided in the text bio under the image.
